The sales goal is 1,000 pizzas sold. Can you help? Attached please find an easy to use envelope to finalize your pizza order. Final payment can be placed inside the attached envelope and returned to the school office by 3:30 p.m. on Tuesday, February 18th, or dropped inside the atrium collection box.

Please make checks payable to Mount Olive. Pizzas will be available for pick up on February 29th from Noon - 2 p.m. or 5:00 p.m. - 6:30 p.m. in the gymnasium vestibule.

Gluten-free crust is also available. Gluten-free orders will need to be placed in a separate envelope. These envelopes can be found in the school office or by the locked collection box in the atrium. Please fill out 2 envelopes if you are ordering both gluten-free and the standard pizza.

The goal of the fundraiser is to support the CEA's annual budget and to hold it every other year, that way when our student body (7th & 8th grade students) organize their educational trip, our church members and school families can contribute to their fundraising needs. Thank you for your support!

Tally all pizza sales on your order form and include final payment in the envelope provided, checks payable to Mount Olive, and submit them to the school office no later than Tuesday, February 18th or to the collection box found in the church atrium. Please write a separate check if you are using a gluten-free envelope order form. Please select the pick up time that works best for you. Pizzas will be available for pick up on February 29th in the gym vestibule from Noon - 2 p.m. or 5 p.m. - 6:30 p.m.

This is not a student or classroom challenge but a school wide challenge with incentives. When the goal of 600 pizzas are sold the classes will have a movie day, 800 pizzas a pajama day and at 1,000 pizzas a student-teacher game challenge event! This should make for some excitement for the students!
