We pray that God will make it possible for us to continue in-person education in the new year. The Board of Christian Education met to discuss current activity at Mount Olive and reviewed the newly updated CDC guidelines. Mount Olive administration reserves the right to make classroom decisions that they feel is in the best interest of the students and teachers.

If you test positive for COVID, regardless of vaccination status:

- Remain home for 5 days from the day of the COVID test. Day 0 is the day of the COVID test.
- May return to school on day 6 so long as they are fever free for 24-hours.
- Masks are encouraged for days 6-10.

Fully Vaccinated

In case of close contact with a COVID-positive member of your household:

Students can continue to attend school as normal as long as they are symptom-free. Masking is encouraged for days 0-10.

Fully vaccinated defined:

- You have received the eligible booster.
- You completed the initial Pfizer or Moderna vaccine series within the last 6 months.
- You have received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine within the last 2 months.

• You have received a confirmed positive test result in the last 90 days.

Students may return on Day 6. Day 0 is last date in close-contact with household member. Symptom-free. Masking is encouraged for days 6-10.
